

Standards System Complaints Report 2024

The following is a report of complaints received by Textile Exchange related to our standard systems between January 1 through October 1, 2024. This report is provided publicly on the <u>Textile Exchange</u> website.


Complaints received by Textile Exchange related to Textile Exchange standards, standards logos, and scheme participants are evaluated according to the <u>ASR-110 Complaints and Feedback Policy</u>. These cases are recorded and assessed by the Assurance Monitoring team, which also manages and coordinates investigations in collaboration with accreditation and certification bodies where applicable.

Complaints Management

As of October 1, 2024, within 2024 Textile Exchange has received 115 complaints related to our standards system, making a decrease of 10% percent in comparison to 2023.

As a result of the investigations, as of October 1, 2024, there has been 4 additional bans published in 2024 so far. For further details, please refer to <u>ASR-225 Certification Eligibility Policy and List of Banned Entities</u>, where the list of banned entities (both active and expired) is updated periodically.
